## **Effective date for ISU Communications**

---

All skaters, coaches, officials and competition organisers are advised that the recently released ISU Communication Nos 1610 and 1611, will not take effect for Australian competitions until the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2010.

The ISU Communications that are to be used for ALL competitions until the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2010 are 1557 and 1587 for Singles and Pairs and 1567 and 1583 for Dance.

From 1st July 2010 any changes to Program Elements for Junior and Senior (Singles, Pairs, Dance and Synchronized) adopted by the ISU Congress will be automatically applied for all Competitions and Championships in Australia.

From July 1st 2010 any Levels, Scale of Values and GOE guidelines contained in ISU Communication 1610, 1611 and subsequent communications will be applied to all Competitions and Championships in Australia.

Ice Skating Australia are aware that skaters need to start working on their programs for the upcoming season incorporating these new rules, but ISA are also mindful that we should not be pre-empting rule changes that could occur at the ISU Congress nor allow two sets of rules to be utilised for competitions.
