Technical Requirements	This competition will be held in accordance with: - ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules - All pertinent ISU Communications - All pertinent ISA Regulations and Communications, see isa.org.au
Other Requirements	State Championship entrants must have met championship eligibility requirements. See Policy section on the SAISA website.
Results	The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all ISA Divisions. Unless notified otherwise before the event, Aussie Skate will be marked using the Aussie Skate 6.0 system, which is closed marking. Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until certified by the Referee and Technical Controller on the official result form.
Judges	Judging panel will be organised by the SA judging convener in collaboration with the ISA Chair Judging and Officials as required.
Membership Requirements	At close of entries, all competitors must be fully financial members of SAISA (or another State body) and the membership must be valid during the full competition period. All Aussie Skate entrants must also be registered with ISA.

Eligibility to Compete	<p>Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant test level/s at the close of entries. Championship entrants also must have met the Championship requirements (Policy Section SAISA website).</p> <p>Competitors in Aussie Skate divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed. Skaters who have passed the ISA Preliminary Test are not permitted to compete at Aussie Skate level (see new ISA Rules for Pair and Dance exceptions).</p> <p>Interstate competitors may enter the Championship events but are not eligible for Championship titles.</p>
Practice Sessions	Official Practices are limited. They will be organised after close of entries.

Entry Process	<p>All forms needed are on the SAISA website Forms page.</p> <p>The Entry Form is a Jotform via the link on the Forms page.</p> <p>Music Details are entered on the Jotform.</p> <p>The PPC form is a paper form.</p> <p>Interstate entries must be verified by the relevant State body.</p>
Payment Process	<p>Direct deposit to SAISA Account BSB 105-105 Account 389743040 (Bank SA).</p> <p>Synchro Team entry fees must be received in total as a team payment.</p> <p>Email notification of a deposit is required.</p>
Entry Conditions	<p>Entries will not be considered complete and in time and will not proceed to the draw unless accompanied by 6 September by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the completed Jotform - a completed Planned Program Content Sheet (PPC) (IJS levels only), send via email - for synchro only: all team forms, - full payment in the SAISA account by 6 September, 5pm, - a music CD received by 6 September, 5pm (see also 'Music' below). <p>Late entries will not be accepted.</p>
Withdrawals	<p>Refund only with a medical certificate provided before the draw.</p> <p>No refund permitted after the draw.</p>
Music	<p>CD only.</p> <p>Each program (short program, free skating, short dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate CD and labelled with ISU standard naming: i.e. Division, Segment, Name, Run Time e.g. ElementaryMen_FS_DavidSmith_2m3s</p> <p>Hand CDs to the Skate School Office by 6 September.</p>
Other Music file notes	All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on CD.
PPC	<p>Email to SAISA by close of entry.</p> <p>Minor corrections only can be received up to the Draw.</p>
Awards/Trophies	<p>Medals will be awarded to all competitors.</p> <p>The Dejan Jovanovic Memorial Trophy and the Abram Family Cup will be awarded by the Jovanovic and Abram families respectively.</p> <p>See SAISA website (Awards) for further information.</p>
Volunteering	Assistance will be needed for: Registration, Ice Marshalling, Runner, Printing
