Entries Close	30 th September 2024. Entries may close early once ice hire is at capacity. Entry Form contains the music upload site and the PPC form. The form will not accepted after this date
Date of Official Draw	6 th October 2024 and conducted by SAISA officials via a Zoom meeting For 2 program events the order of skating in the Free Skate segment will be the reverse order of the Short Program result

Divisions	State Championships: Singles: Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice, Intermediate (ISA), Advanced Novice, Junior, Senior Adult: Silver, Gold, Master, Master Elite Synchro: All Divisions Spring Cup: All other divisions in Aussie Skate, Adult, Singles, Synchro
Technical Requirements	As per current ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules, ISU Communications, ISA Regulations and Communications.
Marking System	The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all Divisions. Aussie Skate marking is closed marking
Results	Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until certified by the Referee and Technical Controller on the official result form
Judges	Judging panel will be organised by the SA judging convenor
Practice Sessions	Official Practices may not be available or may be strictly limited
Membership Requirements	At close of entries, all competitors must be financial members of SAISA (or another State body) and the membership must be valid during the full competition period. All Aussie Skate entrants must be registered with ISA as well as their State body
Guests	Interstate / overseas guests are welcome to apply

Eligibility to Compete	Competitors in Aussie Skate divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed. Skaters who have passed the ISA Preliminary Test are not permitted to compete at Aussie Skate level (see ISA Rules for Pair and Dance exceptions)

Entry Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entry form contains the payment site, music and PPC information and upload sites • Note that skaters must also have a backup copy of their music such as on a USB drive or on their or their coach's rink music tag
Payment Process	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Payment is via the online Entry form • Synchro Team entry fees must be received in total as a team payment
Entry Conditions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entry form and fee, music & PPC must be received by close of entries for the entry to be accepted • Interstate competitors must notify their association prior to entering • Relevant State Associations will be asked to verify entries from interstate skaters
Music Upload	<p>There are 3 aspects to submitting your music:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The name: The name of your music is needed for your Entry form 2. Backup: Skaters must have a backup copy of their music, eg: on a USB drive or on their or their coach's rink music tag 3. Online submission of your music <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Upload site is on your Entry form • The format: MP3 • Free Skate and Short Program Only Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior have Short Programs • Naming: File naming examples are below for ISA levels and Aussie Skate and consist of: your name, the accepted name of the division (and segment if applicable), and the actual length of your music: e.g: JaneDoe_BasicNovice_FS_2m40s
Withdrawals	Refund only with a medical certificate provided before the draw. No refund permitted after the draw
Awards and Trophies	Medals will be awarded
Coach Accreditation	Level 1 coaches and higher only are eligible to present skaters. Coaches must be current members of SAISA or another State body and wear their APSA accreditation ID with evidence of currency with APSA
Working With Children Checks (WWCC)	All coaches, officials and volunteers must have a current WWCC check
Volunteering	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Volunteers are essential for the competition. • Volunteers will be needed for: Judging system set-up and pack-up, Ice Marshal duties at the entrance to the ice, running Official Practice, competition music and announcing, presentations, and with the videoing and video replay for the judging system
