



SA SKATE 2010

Wednesday 14th July & Thursday 15th July

- ORGANISING BODY:** South Australian Ice Skating Association Inc.
- DESCRIPTION:** SA Skate is an annual Interstate Competition for ladies and men, Aussie Skate to Senior and may include Singles, Pairs, Synchronized Team Skating, Solo Dance and Adult.
- VENUE:** Ice ArenA, 23 James Congdon Drive, THEBARTON, SA.
- ICE SURFACE:** 26m x 56m.
- DIVISIONS:** **Expressions of interest are invited as soon as possible.** Options for Pairs, Solo Dance and Ice Dance may be limited by availability of judges. Requests for extra divisions are welcomed.
- Singles:** Preliminary, Elementary, Pre-Primary, Primary, Intermediate, Novice, Junior and Senior.
- Adult/Youth:** Bronze, Silver and Gold. (Youth has the same technical requirements as Adult and is available for skaters aged 13-17 years).
- Aussie Skate:** Tiny Tots to Free Skate 4. Also Aussie Skate Pair 1-4, Ice Dancing 1-4, Synchronized Skating 1-4.
- Pairs:** Pre-Primary and Primary.
- Solo Dance:** Elementary and Adult.
- Synchronized:** All levels.
- DATES:** 14th July (Wednesday) and 15th July (Thursday).
- TIMES:** Competition Times: Wednesday 4.30 – 7.00pm, Thursday 4:30 – 7:30pm
Official Practice Times: Wednesday and Thursday 7.00am – 9.00am.
- CLOSING DATE:** 25th June (Friday).
- DRAW:** Draw for initial start order will take place at the Ice ArenA on: Tuesday 29th of June at 5.30 pm.
- ENTRIES:** All entries must be submitted through State Associations and will be accepted by SAISA until the closing date.
Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of SAISA but will run the risk of not being accepted and will incur a penalty of double the entry fee.

THE ENTRY FEE MUST ACCOMPANY ALL ENTRIES

The preferred option for payments for South Australian competitors is via Direct deposit. The SAISA account details are: BSB 105-105 Account 389743040 (Bank SA). All entry fees include Official Practice.

WITHDRAWALS:

No refund is available after the draw. A fee of 10% will be withheld for withdrawals before the draw.

REGISTRATION:

The official registration desk will be located inside the coffee shop area. Competitors must check in at least **1/2 hour** before the start of the evening's scheduled events.

SPECTATOR ENTRY: \$2 per person.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

All participants in ISA levels must be current **financial members** of their State Association. All Aussie Skaters must be registered with ISA.

PRACTICES:

Practice times will be advised approximately 14 days prior to the competition. The amount of time available for Official Practices is limited and the practice sessions will be short. The entry fee is included in the competition entry.

MUSIC:

Must be provided on a clearly labelled CD. There must be only **ONE** track on the CD. The competitor's name, division, the program type (short or free skate) and the length of the music (not the program) must be written on the CD. The competitor must have a spare copy at the rink. Music must be handed in at registration and must be picked up from the music official.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

The New Aussie Skate curriculum will be used. The conversion chart for comparing the old levels with the new ones is available on the SAISA website (Aussie Skate page) under *Aussie Skate New Curriculum*. ISA levels are as specified for this season by ISA. Please note that new rules were recently released. The relevant documents can be downloaded from the SAISA website (technical page) at www.saisa.org.au

MARKING & DETERMINATION OF RESULTS:

All marking will be closed marking. The 6.0 will be used for Aussie Skate divisions. The ISU Judging System will be used for Singles divisions from Preliminary upwards and wherever possible for Pairs, Solo Dance, Adult, Youth and Synchronised Team events.

TROPHIES:

Trophies/medals will be awarded to all skaters.

PRESENTATIONS:

Presentations will be held off ice in the coffee shop area on each day after all the events have finished. All skaters please remain in costume for photographs.

AFTER COMPETITION DINNER:

Group bookings can be made for skaters and families who would like to get together following the competition at the Royal Hotel, Henley Beach Road.

VIDEO RECORDING & PHOTOGRAPHY:

Photography and videotaping can give rise to child protection concerns.

Flash photography is not allowed during the event as it poses a danger to the skaters. Private photographers must register at the registration desk. Private video-taping of the event is not allowed.

An Official Video (DVD) and photographs of the event will be organized if possible. This will depend on there being sufficient interest. Please indicate on the entry form whether you are interested in purchasing an Official DVD or photographs.
