## STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS & Spring Cup 2010

Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> & Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2010

**ORGANISING BODY:** South Australian Ice Skating Association Inc.

**DESCRIPTION:** The 2010 SA State Figure Skating Championships will be conducted for Ladies and Men in the divisions being presented at this year's National Championships. Spring Cup replaces Winter Challenge as an annual Interstate Competition for Ladies & Men and includes divisions from Aussie Skate® to Pre-Primary.

**VENUE:** Ice ArenA, 23 James Congdon Drive, THEBARTON, SA.

**ICE SURFACE:** 26m x 56m.

**DIVISIONS:**

**State Championships**

Singles: Primary, Intermediate, Novice, Junior.

Synchro: Novice, Junior, Senior, Adult, Open.

Pairs: Primary.

Adult: Silver.

**Spring Cup**

Aussie Skate®: all levels and divisions

Singles: Preliminary, Elementary, Pre-Primary, Adult and Youth.

Solo Dance: Elementary (Dutch Waltz and Fiesta Tango),  
Pre-Primary (European Waltz and March),  
Adult (Canasta Tango and March).

Requests for extra divisions are welcomed but can only be considered if received early.

**DATES:** 11<sup>th</sup> September (Saturday) and 12<sup>th</sup> September (Sunday).

**TIMES:** Saturday 4.30-7:30pm (Short Programs, Compulsory Dances, Pair)  
Sunday 4:30-8:30pm (Free Skating Programs & most Spring Cup events)  
Official Practice Times: Saturday 6:45am-8:15am; Sunday 6:00am-8:15am.

**CLOSING DATE:** 23<sup>rd</sup> August (Monday).

**DRAW:** Draw for initial start order will take place at the Ice ArenA on:  
Monday 30th of August at 5.30 pm.

**ENTRIES:** All entries must be submitted through State Associations and must include PPC forms, music details and payment or evidence of payment to be considered a valid entry. Entries will be accepted by SAISA until the closing date.  
Late entries/incomplete entries may be accepted at the discretion of the SAISA Board but will run the risk of not being accepted and will incur a penalty of double the entry fee.

Preliminary to Pre-Primary \$ 95.00

Primary and above \$ 130.00

Adult/Youth \$ 90.00

Solo Dance \$ 90.00

Pair \$ 70.00

#### Synchronized

Novice, Adult, Open \$ 80.00

Junior and Senior \$ 90.00

*All entry fees include Official Practice.*

## WITHDRAWALS:

A valid medical certificate or acceptable reasons need to be supplied to the Board.

Refund before the draw: entry fee less 10%.

A refund after the draw is only available in exceptional circumstances.

**SPECTATOR ENTRY:** \$2 per person.

## MEMBERSHIP/ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

All Aussie Skaters must be registered with ISA.

All participants must be current **financial members** of their State Association. State Championship entrants must meet the criteria in the guidelines (see website).

## REGISTRATION:

The official registration desk will be located inside the coffee shop area. Competitors must check in at least **1/2 hour** before the start of the evening's scheduled events.

## PRACTICES:

Practice times will be advised approximately 1 week prior to the competition. The amount of time available for Official Practices is limited and the practice sessions will be short. The entry fee is included in the competition entry.

## MUSIC:

Must be provided on a clearly labelled CD.

There must be only **ONE** track on the CD. The competitor's name, division, the program type (short or free skate) and the length of the music (not the program) must be written on the CD.

The competitor must have a spare copy at the rink.

The Official Practice Session is a good opportunity to confirm your music is working. Music must be handed in at registration and must be picked up from the music steward after the event.

## TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

The New Aussie Skate® curriculum will be used. Other levels are as specified for this season by ISA. The 'Youth' section is the technical equivalent of Adult and is offered for under 18 year olds. Please check the SAISA website (technical page) at [www.saisa.org.au](http://www.saisa.org.au) for Rule updates.

## MARKING & DETERMINATION OF RESULTS:

Aussie Skate and Solo Dance will use closed marking and 6.0. All other divisions will use IJS wherever possible. In the event of computer failure the results for the Championships divisions will be calculated manually and will be delayed. Other divisions MAY continue using 6.0.

## TROPHIES/MEDALS/TITLES:

Trophies/medals will be awarded to all skaters. Guest skaters are welcome to enter the Championships competition and will also receive appropriate medals/trophies but will remain ineligible for the titles.

## PRESENTATIONS:

Presentations will be held off ice in the coffee shop area after all the events have finished. Any event concluding on Day 1 will be presented that day. All skaters please remain in costume for photographs.

## AFTER COMPETITION DINNER:

Due to the timing of the competition formal dinner arrangements will not be possible. The registration desk can help with group dinner or lunch arrangements if required.

## VIDEO RECORDING & PHOTOGRAPHY:

Photography and videotaping can give rise to child protection concerns.

Flash photography is not allowed during the event as it poses a danger to the skaters.

Private videotaping of the event is not allowed. An Official Video (DVD) and photographs of the event will be organized if there is sufficient interest. Please see Entry Form.

## Payment Options:

The preferred option for payments is by Direct Deposit via the internet or over-the-counter at a branch of BankSA or St. George Bank.
