| <b>Other Requirements</b>                     | <b>Eligibility for State Championships</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Skaters will have competed in SA Skate 2022 or received a bye and met the eligibility requirements as per the SAISA Championship &amp; Competition Guidelines</li> </ul>   |
| <b>COVID-Safety Requirements</b>              | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Please be aware basic COVID-19 safety measures are in place at the IceArena. Hand sanitizer stations are available. Any traffic flow signs and distancing requirements must be observed. Change rooms are only to be used for the time it takes to change in or out of costumes/sports gear. Maximum numbers allowed in the change rooms may be posted on the room entry door.</li> <li>Competitors should arrive dressed in performance clothes, if possible</li> <li>Competitors are advised to warm-up at home or away from the rink as much as possible.
