Results	The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all Divisions, Preliminary and above.		
	Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until the results are certified by the segment Referee and Technical Controller on the official result form.		
Judges	Judging panel will be organised by the SA judging convenor in conjunction with ISA and will comply with Benchmark requirements.		
Membership Requirements	At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an affiliated club. (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their state association).		
	Membership must be valid during the full competition period.		
	All Aussie Skate™ entrants must also be registered with ISA Aussie Skate™ and currently enrolled in Aussie Skate™		
	Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.		
Insurance/Liability	All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover.		
	ISA SAISA & SBFSC assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.		
	ISA recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.		
	Coaches are expected to be insured via APSA and accredited.		
Eligibility to Compete	Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant ISA test level at the close of entries.		
	Competitors in Aussie Skate™ divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed.		
	Skaters who have passed the ISA Preliminary Test at close of entries are not permitted to compete at Aussie Skate™ level.		
Schedule	8 th April from 3pm to 7pm 9 th April from 3pm to 7pm		
	Registration desk will be open 1 hour before the competition start.		
	Final confirmation of schedule will be available after registration closing date.		
Volunteering	Volunteers are essential for the competition. Volunteers will be needed for: Judging system set-up and pack-up, Ice Marshal duties at the entrance to the ice, running Official Practice, competition music and announcing, presentations, and with the videoing and video replay for the judging system
